Until March 31<sup>st</sup> the fee for Senior/graduation is \$105.00 which includes your cap/gown and tassel and various other senior & graduation expenses. This price increases to \$125.00 on **APRIL 1<sup>st</sup>**, so pay ASAP in A110! Payment plans must be set up with Ms. Frisbee by March 31<sup>st</sup>.

## Other Important Information:

**College Banner Forms:** If the student plans on attending a college/university or enlisting in the US Military, they can choose to be recognized with a banner. These forms can be picked up outside of A110 or printed off of the class website. Forms must be returned to A110 by April 4th.

**Graduation Dress Code:** Every graduate should arrive to graduation in the appropriate attire. Ladies should wear an all white dress or skirt with white shoes (be sure you can walk comfortably in your shoes). Gentlemen need to wear blue or black pants, a white shirt with a blue tie, and in dark shoes and socks. No jeans, sneakers, or flip flops! Do not bring phones, cameras, sunglasses... Any unnecessary items brought to the ceremony will be held until 2 pm outside the graduate entrance at the arena. Items not picked up by 2 pm may be picked up at NHS on Tuesday, May 27<sup>th</sup> during office hours.

**Tickets:** We anticipate each graduate will receive 10 tickets to graduation. Students needing additional tickets should check with their friends as many students do not need all 10 tickets. The cost of tickets is included in the graduation fee. Under no circumstances should a student pay another student for tickets.
